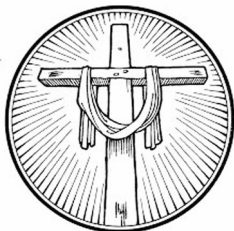

Calendar Planning

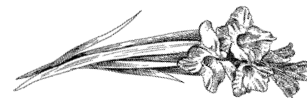

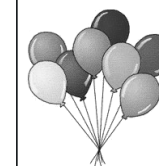

On today's cover Benjamin West's *The Incredulity of St. Thomas* shows the apostle as he touches the risen Christ's wound to assure himself of Jesus' physical existence. West (1738-1820) was born in Springfield, Pennsylvania, but moved to London as a young man and co-founded the Royal Academy of Arts, for which he later served two terms as president. The painting hangs in the Leeds Museums and Galleries in Leeds, England.
