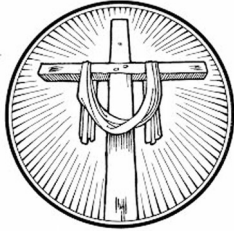

Holy Cross School Musical

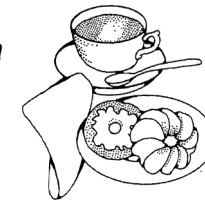
