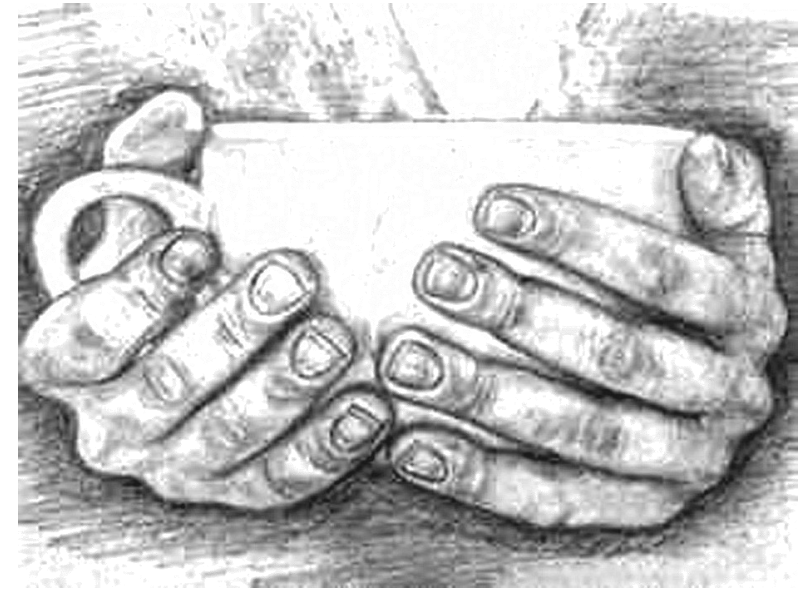

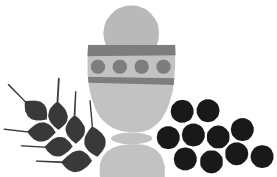

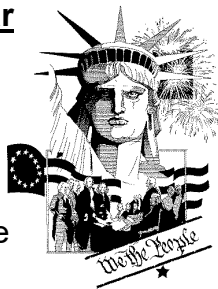

**Baby Shower**

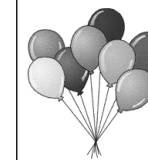

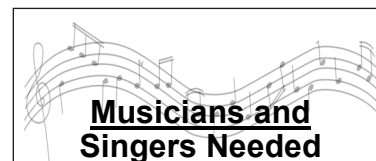
