Update from Commonwealth Catholic Charities

Another Good Measure of Hope

Over the last year, CCC's Homeless Services team implemented a new strategy to that showed a significant increase in the number of households that were prevented from becoming homeless, while also saving money. According to Abby Boyd, Program Manager, CCC Homeless Services, "We have been able to assist more people, keep more people off the streets, and have greatly reduced the costs of service." The homelessness diversion strategies prevented 101 households from becoming homeless, a 777% increase in positive exits from the previous year while also saving over \$9,300 per client. Implementing homelessness diversion strategies enabled CCC to serve 200 more individuals this year than in the previous year.

A CCC Client Reflection

From a former homeless client: "God used CCC to bless me. When you're down to absolutely nothing, that just means God is up to something."
