Dear Fr. Jim and Our Lady of Peace Parishioners,

Victor and I want to express our thanks to the many people at Our Lady of Peace who have helped us tremendously with food, transportation, shopping and laundry. I am continuing to heal at home and Victor is back at work. My left hand is out of the cast and I have started physical therapy to get back to using it. I am still in the cervical collar and will be for at least two more weeks. At that time, the doctor will take another x-ray - then we will go from there.

We are looking forward to attending mass and joining our prayers with those of our friends at Our Lady of Peace very soon.
