Thoughts from the Music Ministry: The following are excerpts from the article written by Becky Roach for The Catholic Link March 10, 2017: "Should You Sing at Mass Even If You Can't Carry a Tune?" "Sometimes we are tempted to listen to the singing of the choir or the listen to the musicians. But it isn't a show – IT IS MASS. This is our highest form of worship and prayer and it is not a spectator sport. We are called to fully give of ourselves in order to be a part of the prayer of the Mass. Even if you're not the best singer in the church, we are told to "make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth; break forth into joyous song and praises" (Psalm 98:4-6). "The musical tradition of the universal Church is a treasure of inestimable value, greater even than that of any other art." (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1156)." "Remember, when you sing with joy to God, He hears the prayers of your heart. Even if it sounds a bit off key to everyone else, God is pleased with your desire to praise Him!" To those of you who always sing, thank you; to those of you who think you cannot sing, please sing anyway. Let us all make a beautiful noise to the Lord!
