Kairos Cookies

Cookies are needed for Kairos Prison Ministry. Some prison residents come for cookies and are surprised by God's grace. The types of cookies that are generally acceptable are oatmeal, peanut butter, molasses, chocolate chip, lemon and ginger. Cookies with fruits, nuts, and sugar coating on top are NOT permitted inside the prison.

Place one dozen thoroughly cooked cookies in a quart sized Ziploc bag (no fold over sandwich bags). Label each bag with a marker stating the type of cookie. Freeze the cookies if not to be delivered in three days.
