The whole community rejoices as Beatrice Heady will come to the table of the Lord for the first time on Mothers' Day and Feast of the Ascension.

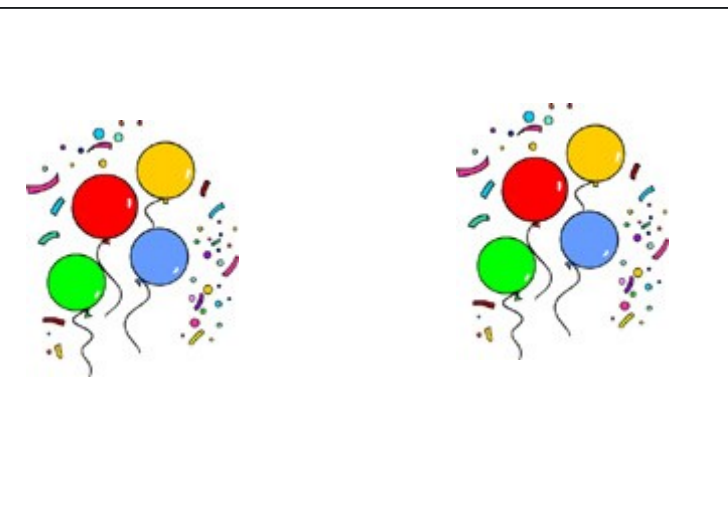
