The Giving Tree

The Christmas Gift Ministry at the Fluvanna Correctional Center for Women in Troy, VA began the Christmas of 1998, the year the correctional center opened. It is sponsored through the Chaplain Service Prison Ministry of VA (GraceInside). Supported entirely by donations from individuals, churches and organizations throughout state of VA, and administered through Effort Baptist Church, Palmyra VA, which is the delivery point for all donations. This community examines and prepares all the gifts to enter the facility.

Each of the approximate 1,300 inmates receive all the gifts listed below. Indigent inmates are also eligible to receive the hygiene packet throughout the year. In order to be ready for the Thanksgiving deadline, the "Giving Tree" will be up and ready to receive the donations, starting with the Hygiene items. Please note, the correctional center does not permit any substitute or additional products.

Hygiene Kit (Place in a gallon zip lock bag)

1. One individually wrapped toothbrush
2. One tube of toothpaste, 6 oz. (must be in original container)
3. One deodorant stick, 2.6 oz. (no spray or roll-on)
4. One bottle of shampoo, 15 oz.
5. One bottle of lotion, 15 oz.
