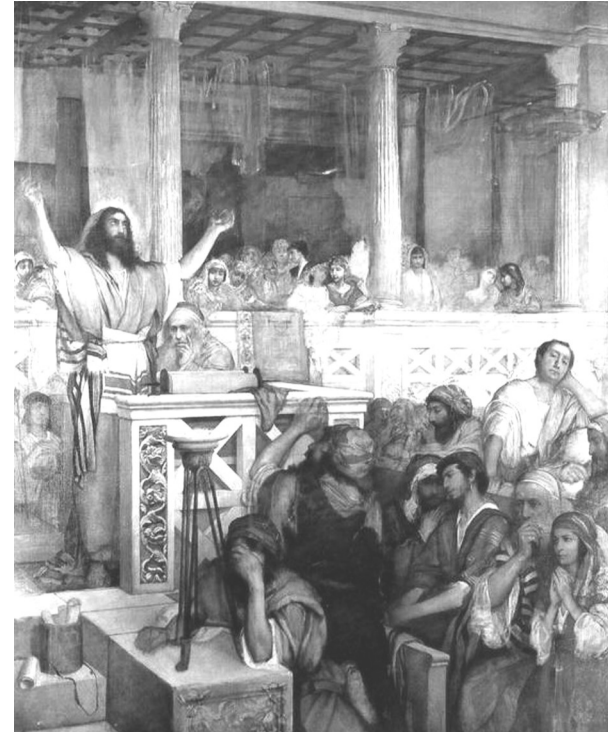

**Parish Picnic**

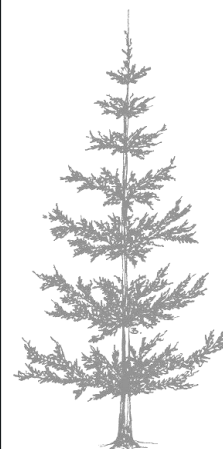
