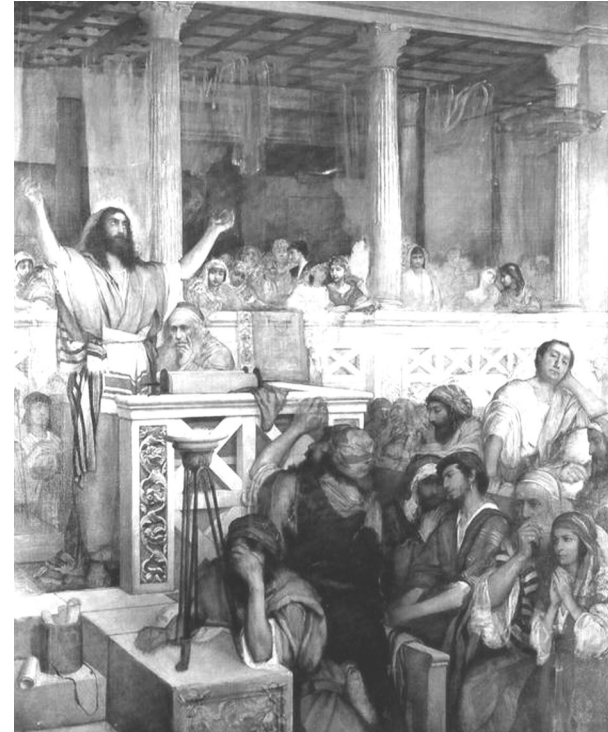

Parish Picnic

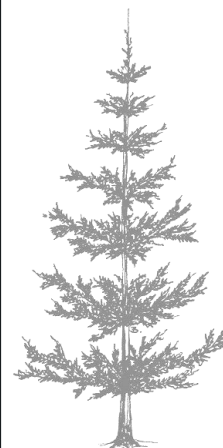
