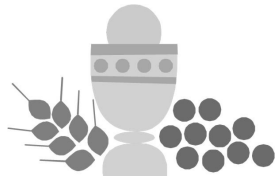

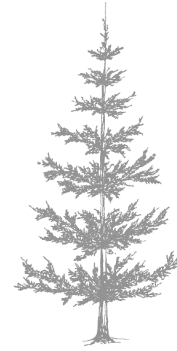

Anyone wishing to donate money, make check payable to "Chaplain Service Prison Ministry of VA, memo "FCCW Resource Fund". Funds are used in supporting inmates such as providing worship materials or paying travel expenses for funeral or deathbed visits.
