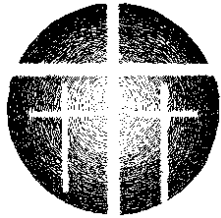


Tanks for the Memories
