

On the Cover

Lorenzo Monaco was a fifteenth century Florentine painter. The *Flight into* Egypt on our cover is one of his most admired works. It was done about 1406 and is tempera on poplar wood with gold leaf. This panel formed part of a predella - a painting or sculpture along the bottom of an altarpiece. On this predella he also painted a *Visitation*, a *Nativity*, and an *Adoration of the Magi*. In his depiction of the Holy Family's flight, Monaco shows us the Virgin riding the ass side-saddle, as though she were sitting on a throne. He also depicts a younger and more vigorous Joseph similar to the portrait Mengs gave us in the dreaming Joseph on the cover last week.
