The ongoing effort of Virginia's Catholics to prove they were real Americans continued during 1931's sesquicentennial celebration of the battle of the Yorktown and the end of the Revolutionary War. Bishop Brennen designated Fr. Richard B. Washington—a "collateral descendent of George Washington" and thus himself a symbol of Catholic America—to say the celebratory mass marking the victory at Yorktown on Sunday, October 18th, 1931.




