Bishop Walter Sullivan—frequently referenced by Fr. Jim—became the eleventh bishop of Richmond on June 6, 1974. Serving in the office for 29 years, he was the last bishop to preside over the entirety of the state of Virginia and the first to preside over the diocese in its current form. Sullivan had been a close friend and assistant of Bishop Russell. As bishop, he continued Russell's efforts to advance social justice, racial justice, ecumenism, and the laity. As part of this broader outreach, he also actively encouraged the establishment of parishes in previously neglected areas: most notably, Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church in Appomattox (1982).

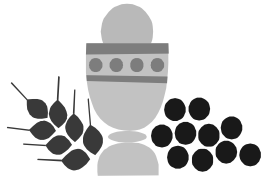

in Christmas**

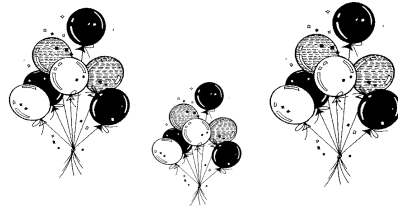
The KOC will be selling
