Bishop Russell's work for social justice included a commitment to fair housing and to integrating racially segregated neighborhoods. In 1965, he worked with Rabbi Noah Golinkin and the Protestant minister Rev. David Colwell to organize a convocation on Fair Housing that was attended by Stewart Udall, the Secretary of the Interior. At the conclusion of the convocation, a formal statement in favor of Fair Housing was signed by 15,000+ members of all three faiths.

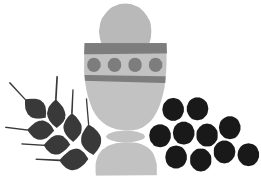

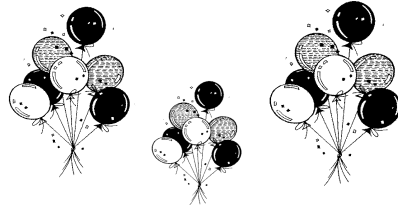
