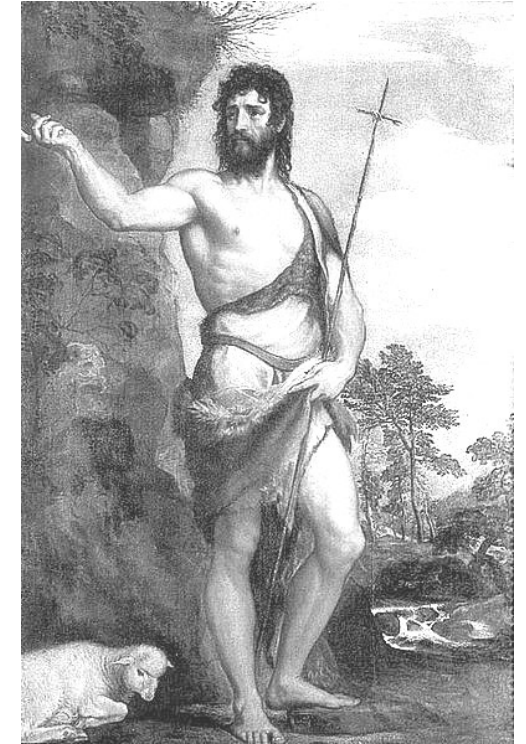

**No Christmas Gifts for Fr. Jim this year**

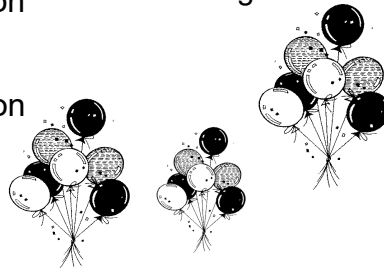
