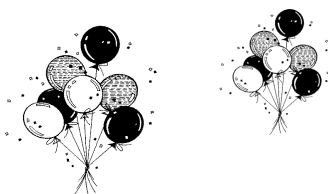
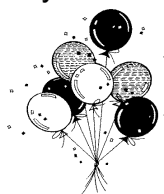

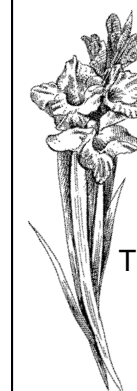
Clinic and others offsite.
