**Memorable Moments in Diocesan History**

1963 was a watershed moment for civil rights in the diocese of Richmond. Bishop Russell wrote a pastoral letter on the subject that he required to be read aloud in all churches of the diocese. The same month, Dorothy Day—the founder of the Catholic Worker movement, whose cause for canonization is now under consideration—traveled to Danville to give a lecture in favor of integration and to participate in protests against segregation.

### Knights of Columbus Degree Ceremony

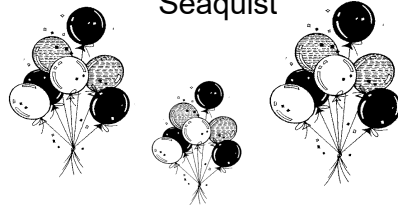
