John Collier painted this Annunciation in 2000 for the Church of Saint Gabriel in McKinney, Texas. This Annunciation is clearly set in in a modern suburban neighborhood, but the symbolism is very traditional. Mary, dressed in blue, is reading from Isaiah about the Virgin who conceives and bears a son. The lily represents her purity, and she is welcoming the Angel Gabriel who is shown in a robe and with wings.


