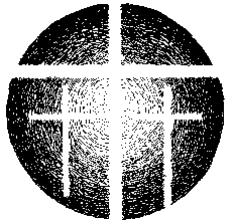

**Fr. Jim to Attend Chrism Mass**

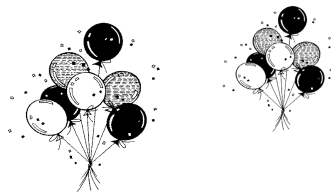
