

#### A PASTORAL MOMENT WITH FR. JIM

We are anticipating the Marion Feast of The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15. It comes this year in the midst of the "Bread of Life Discourse" found in John, Chapter 6, which runs three or four Sundays. But there is a definite connection between Mary and John 6.

I like to refer to it as the "Priesthood of Mary." As a child born, Jesus is formed from Mary's substance to be our sustenance. From Mary we are given and presented with Jesus body, blood, soul and divinity. "This is my body. This is my blood." To that end, I would like to share a poem and reflection written by Irene Zimmerman: "This is My Body, My Blood"

All the way to Elizabeth and in the months afterward, She wove him, pondering: "This is my body, my blood."

Beneath the watching eyes of a donkey, ox and sheep, she rocked him crooning: "This is my body, my blood."

In the moonless desert flight and the Egypt days of his growing, she nourished him singing: "This is my body, my blood."

Under the blood smeared cross she rocked his mangled bones remembering him, moaning: "This is my body, my blood."

When darkness, stones and tomb bloomed to Easter morning, She ran to him shouting: "This is my body, my blood!"

And no one thought to tell her: "Woman, it is not fitting for you to say those words, you don't resemble him."

But Mary continues to say: "This is my body, my blood!"
