A PASTORAL MOMENT WITH FR. JIM

In his song "Follow Me", John Denver's lyrics are very profound.

"Follow me where I go, what I do, who I know;
Make is part of you to be a part of me.
Follow me up and down, all the way and all around.
Take my hand, say you'll follow me."

Simple bread, blessed and broken for us. His body - so that he could be a part of us. We come to the table so we can be a part of him and part of one another. We come. We eat. We drink so that in Him and by His power, by His substance to be our sustenance, we are no long alone but belong. We are no longer lonely but belong to each other. The power of broken bread - His broken body.
