I think many of us "Trekkies" remember when the first Star Trek movie came out in 1978. It has been a long time since the television show had ended and we were hungry to see Spock, bones and, of course, Captain James Kirk. There were many other Star Trek movies to follow, but I delighted in the first one. The movie opened up with an alien flying a space vehicle.
