A PASTORAL MOMENT WITH FR. JIM

Didn't you enjoy some of the old Saturday Night Live skits from back in the 1980's and 1990's? My favorite skit always involved Bill and Wendy Whiner. Their last name speaks for itself. They would complain about everything. As they complained, it sounded sickening. It was so bad that when they had a home invasion and the burglars tied them up, they whined and whined and it hurt the burglars' ears - so bad that the robbers untied them and ran out of the house empty handed!

I wonder if the early Christians whined like that when Jesus went to the Father. Imagine the separation anxiety and the anxiety about carrying out the new mission. One had to have great faith in the Holy Spirit to have made it this far, even stumbling and bumbling as we go along. Perhaps instead of looking up to the sky, they looked deep within. I believe the Holy Spirit has accompanied us through history.

I think that there are three ways of leading. One is pontificating. In other words, leading from above. Dictating and being foreign to the experience of the sheep. For example, a bishop and district superintendent who never pastored a rural parish tells you what you should do. A Catholic Priest who has no children tells married couples how to raise their children or worse yet, tells them to have children. Tha+t is pontificating!

A second way is teaching people for a while and then abandoning them. I have been guilty of that. Leaving parishes and saying, "What's the matter with those folks" I taught them how to do it." While it is better than pontificating, it can also be arrogant.

The third way is the way of the Holy Spirit: accompanying people and walking with them - getting your hands dirty in the ministry to be done. Pope Francis said, "We need leaders who have the smell of the sheep on their hands."

Accompaniment says like the theme song from Friends: "I'll be there for you." Accompaniment does not mean being the people's co-dependent and ministering for them. It means ministering with them. We learn from each other. "If I have to leave, I will be back to advise, nurture and affirm."

All of us Christians ritualize accompaniment. We all have the Lord's Supper. One point of convergence for all of us is that Jesus is still with us in the breaking of the bread.

I often wonder is the teaching of my church in regards to family and marriage would have more credibility if we had a Pope we called "Mamma" instead of "Papa." that would be true, especially is "Mama" had six children.

Perhaps that time is long overdue. That would be accompaniment!
